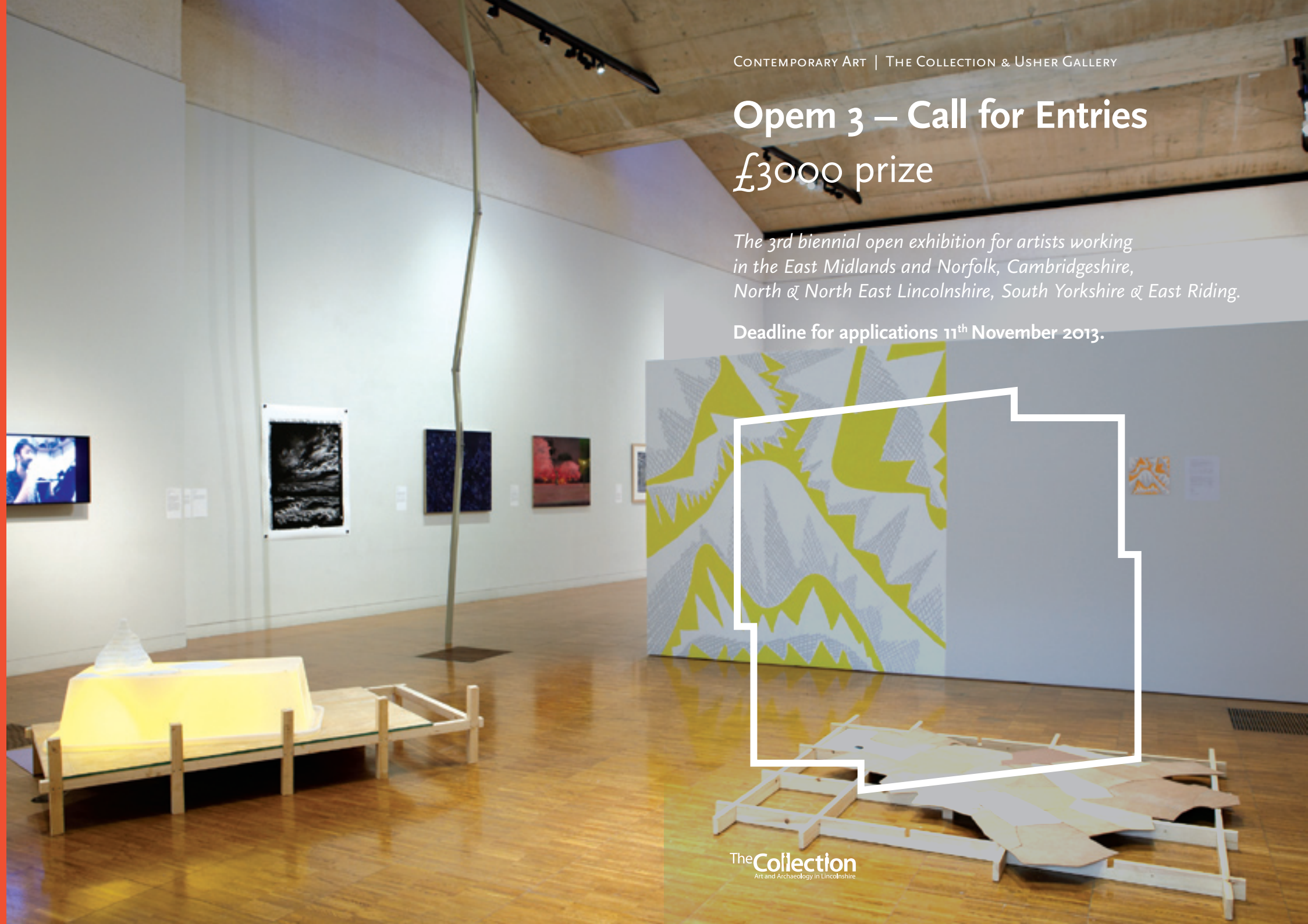

Send by post, via web file transfer or e-mail attachment.

We recommend a maximum resolution of 72dpi and maximum pixel dimensions of 1024 pixels wide or high up to 2MB in size as your work will be projected for judging purposes.

If you are working in moving image and are showing more than one work, please make a show reel on a single DVD or CD.

All files should be named in the following format:
